Lesson Plan for "Loto" or "Bingo"

Grade Level: This lesson can be used for any grade, as the verbs chosen for the game will depend on the verbs known by the class.

Length of Activity: This activity will take two classes. Each part of the activity should only take up 10-15 minutes of each class.

Prior Knowledge: Most of the verbs used should be known to students, as they would have already worked on verbs in prior lessons and grades.

Purpose for the Activity: By playing this game, students will have the opportunity to practice the verbs they already know while having fun playing the game of Bingo and interacting with peers and the teacher.

Pre-Class Preparation: Before class starts, the teacher should have a list of 25 verbs written on the board. The verbs should vary in English and French translations, so that the students can write in the opposite language word below on the Bingo board.

For example, the word on the board would be "aller." The student would then fill this in on their Bingo sheet and then write the English translation below.

The teacher should hand out place markers for the students to use on their Bingo board, for when a verb is called out.

Activity: Part 1: The first part of the activity consists of the students taking the various 25 verbs from the board and filling them out on their own personal Bingo card. Students will also write the translations of verbs underneath the already given word.

Activity: Part 2: The next day, for 10-15 minutes, students will play the game of Bingo. The teacher will call out the verbs (either the English or French verbs: whatever form it was on the board) and students will put a place marker on the word the teacher calls out (does not go under a certain letter). *The star in the middle of the card is a free space and can be filled right away. *Students can play to fill either a full Bingo card, or a row or column to win.
